Minimum Testing Guidelines (Anesthesia Service): These guidelines are suggested minimums. They are not replacement for medical judgment, and the patient's medical history and/or the proposed surgical procedure may indicate additional laboratory or diagnostic testing. No pre-operative laboratory testing is required for asymptomatic patients without significant medical problems who are less than 40 years of age, except for an Hgb/Hct for 0–6 months as per protocol, and except for urine HCG. ECG: Males, aged 40 and above require an ECG. Males and Females aged 50 and above require ECG CXR: CXRs are not required in the absence of cardiorespiratory disease. Inpatients with cardiorespiratory disease, a CXR with the past six months is sufficient in the absence of a significant change in status of the cardiorespiratory illness. Pregnancy Test: A pregnancy test is required for all menstruating females scheduled for anesthesia or surgery, unless not indicated due to sterility. This test will be a serum HCG if blood is drawn for other tests. Otherwise it will be a urine HCG.
